
Friedman City while serving as State Representative. Mike was a citizen of Duncan City as he held the position of Supervisor of Streets.

*Mr. Clyde Belew, the Bulldog scorekeeper, announced his retirement after thirty years of hard work and devotion to Gleason's Athletic Program.*






### Is This A Dream?




## First Grade — Thriving On Chaos
