Friedman City while serving as State Representative. Mike was a citizen of Duncan City as he held the position of Supervisor of Streets.


Amy was a citizen of Crockett City and held the office of Chairman of the Board of Education. Beth was a citizen of Blount City while serving as City Councilwoman.

This land IS your land: this land IS my land. I will strive to keep America beautiful in heart and mind. I will fight to preserve our American heritage. Won't you?"








Pomp And Circumstance

















May 27, 1990 — a day of laughter and tears, a day of sorrow and joy, a day of remembrance and anticipation. This is graduation day!


This special event is a "threshold to the future" as each graduate steps forward to pursue his/her own individual goals.








First Grade — Thriving On Chaos
